## Fishing Rules & Information

- : You will need your own tackle and bait. We do have loaner rods available. Robinsons will have bait for sale.**
- : Prize Categories: Biggest Fish 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>, most fish & Drawings (One adult and one child teams only to win the "most fish" prize)**
- : Only one rod per fisherman**
- : Catch and release only**
- : Each fish must be weighed and recorded by scale master to get credit**
- : All Robinson's lake rules must be followed**
- : All decisions made by officials are final**
- : No drugs or alcohol**
- : You cannot use fish out of lake as bait (bream)**
- : YOU MUST HAVE FUN!!!**

I just wanted to let you know what kind of bait may work best. Chicken livers work well for catching a lot of fish. Cut bait like shad or bream work good for big fish. Catawba worms seem to also work. You may want to try fishing your bait with a bobber keeping your bait around 2 or 3 foot deep. Rigged on the bottom also works.
